

Small grants

We are proposing that PLANETBigbury **Community Chest** is a small grant scheme to support activities within our community that:

- save energy and
- restore habitats for wildlife.

Each year, grants of up to £2,000 will be offered to local homeowners, businesses and farms to support any of the PLANETBigbury Mission Objectives (p1)

Benefits

We believe this community-led initiative will strengthen the resolve of residents and businesses to build climate resilience and enhance the natural beauty within the parish of Bigbury.

PLANETBigbury acknowledges that our parish has a role to play in addressing the global biodiversity and climate change emergencies.

It offers a mechanism that brings all sectors of our community together in a meaningful collaborative endeavour.



PLANETBigbury Launch Programme

Step 1

Obtain offers of financial support (p2) from local businesses for a launch in February 2025 (venue to be decided).

Step 2

Identify and invite other potential donors to contribute to the start up **PLANETBigbury Community Chest** before Feb 25.

Step 3

Organise online donations and click and donate points at businesses.

Step 4

Agree funding criteria and methodology for small grants with major donors.

Step 5

Appoint independent panel to review applications and make awards on an annual basis. First grant likely to be made in December 2025.

Step 6

Design public engagement materials to describe project, invite donations and seek views of community on each of the Mission topics (p1) before Feb 25.

Step 7

Design and publish **PLANETBigbury Directory** to be distributed with the Bigbury & Ringmore News in Dec/Jan. The Directory will provide guidelines for local action to support each of the PLANETBigbury Mission Objectives and it will advertise each of our local businesses as well as signpost local renewable energy and wildlife advisors.

Step 8

Organise quarterly reports on income and applications to be published in parish magazine, notice boards and website.

Step 9

Organise annual review of applications and grantees.

Step 10

Organise annual award ceremony.







PLANETBigbury Directory


An annual publication will promote the donors and grantees - what they achieved with a small grant from the Community Chest or what they are planning to do with a new grant

It's great to have local businesses that stay open all year round. It's part of the joy of living in Bigbury.


